## BACnet on the move – success factors in modern building automation

Efficient building management is increasingly the result of intelligent building automation. BACnet offers the market a supplier-neutral, license-free standard that spans across systems and offers a lot of potential. BACnet became a worldwide standard in 2003.

On December 1st, 2005, representatives from the construction, installation and real estate sectors as well as suppliers of building automation and control technology will meet in Krakow for the first independent BACnet Users Forum in Poland since the ISO standardization.

On the initiative of the independent BACnet Interest Group Europe (BIG-EU) they will take a look at cost effectiveness, applications and future possibilities for the standard. The forum is the first of its kind. The BIG-EU also wants to identify new wishes and requirements of users. In cooperation with the international standard committee it can influence further developments of the standard.

This year the BACnet world is looking back on the standard's 10 years of success. For the BIG-EU the 10 year landmark is another reason for emphasizing BACnet as the key to integrated building automation. Through the integration of different systems, BACnet contributes to cost savings. This makes users eager to experience more of the advantages of open systems. In Krakow we want to give everyone the chance to find out more.
